Replace with economical, low maintenance, native/drought resistant plants.

Considerations:

Simplicity of design

Changing climate/water restrictions

Increase paved area at pool deep end to lower maintenance and water usage

Phased project – courtyard, 2nd Street entrance, pool

Proposals requested from the following landscapers:

1. Lesli Larmon, Owner, FL Native Landscape & Design (St. Pete)

Full service landscape design and installation

30 yrs in business, 5 city of St. Pete beautification awards

Plants trees annually for HONNA in Old NE

2. Shane, Sales, Fieldstone Landscaping Services (Clearwater)

One-Stop shop for landscaping design/install, maintenance, tree trimming, irrigation

15+ yrs, Luxury design, resi/bus/HOA

Recommends cleaning out aged plantings, mulch temporarily and plant in the spring
